Treasurer's Report: See Addendum I. The treasurer's report was approved.

The January minutes were approved.

CPYSL: There was no CPYSL report.

LANCO: There was no LANCO report.

Team Fines for Non-Attendance: The boys U11 team will post a bond for missing the November meeting. The boys and girls U17 teams were not represented at the February meeting.

Honor Roll members sought: The club is attempting to assemble at York United College Honor Roll to be listed on the website, detailing all former players who have played or are currently playing collegiate soccer. Anyone with information should contact Tim Holden.

New Uniform designs: The club selected the Adidas design mentioned in the January minutes by a 6-3 vote over Xara. The club decided to go with the red Onore jersey and the Campo short. It was considered to wear black shorts, rather than an all-red look, but that has since been vetoed. After seeing the combination, it was decided that the all red was a superior look for the club. The uniform designs are available for viewing on the club website. Uniforms are to be ordered through Angelo's Soccer Corner.

Tryouts posted: All team tryout schedules are available and posted on the website. Ben Kettlewell will be taking one of the incoming U11 teams, and a trainer is being sought after for the other team.

Tryout standards: Rich Chilcoat has agreed to lead an investigation into having tryout standards for the 2008 tryouts. The goal is to have all teams using at least some of the same criteria for evaluating players, including the use of an independent evaluator, one not connected with the team, to assist in judging talent.

Training fee schedule: The club is also looking into a “training fee schedule” to provide a basis for payment of paid trainers. This could be a per player fee per month, or per training session, based in part on the trainer’s licensing and professional playing/coaching experience.

Field “payments”: The club decided to make a \$300 “good faith” donation to York Country Day School for its part in providing fields for teams to use. YCD has provided practice time and space and could possibly provide more in the future.

Equipment manager: Rich Chilcoat has agreed to find the club an equipment manager due to the departure of Don Allison. Chilcoat will use Penn State York facilities (equipment shed) to keep all club equipment stored in a centrally located place.

Banquet chairperson: Kent Neff agreed to be the club’s new banquet chairperson for the upcoming banquet, to be held June 4 at the Holiday Inn Holidome, behind the West Manchester Mall.

Merger news: Club representatives continue to meet with counterparts from Metro, York Premier, and York USA, exploring the possibility of combining and creating one premier soccer club for York County. The talks are going well, and the merger will not be able to be put into place for at least another year. Tryouts will be held as scheduled this spring and we will play another year independently. The merger could take many forms, including multiple teams at age divisions, where necessary and appropriate, and having the current teams continuing independently and creating the new club with incoming U11 teams next year. These are part of the ongoing dialogue. Monthly meetings will be held between the groups.
