- Treasurers Report was handed out.
 - Coaches/Asst. Coaches need to fill out the coach's agreement and W9. If these documents are not completed coaches will not get paid.
 - Each team should only pay the registration fee for a maximum of 18 players (\$2,250). If teams have more than 18 players divide the \$2,250 by the number of rostered players.

- Spirit Wear
