MEETING MINUTES  
Penn State – York  
Tuesday, January 08 @ 7:30pm

- **Non-profit paperwork and status: Amy Nelson**
- **Budget Process: Dave Stewart**
  - There were 3 budget proposals
    - 1 – pay payroll taxes; reduced registration fee for U12 and below
    - 2 – pay payroll taxes; same fee for all levels
    - 3 – do not pay payroll taxes – coaches will receive 1099; reduced fee
  - It was proposed to continue to evaluate different coaching coordinator candidates and leave the budget available.
  - There may be a legal and financial risk for the club and its members if it chooses not to pay payroll taxes for paid coaches or issue a 1099 for the paid coaches.
  - Coaching fees will be submitted by each team to the club and then distributed back to the coaches.
- **FC York by-laws: must be completed for February approval**
  - Proposal to modify York United by-laws to create FC York by-laws
  - Proposal to use July through June as the club fiscal calendar
- **York USA approval of FC York pending by-laws and \$100 bond**
  - The formation of FC York was well received by York USA
  - The goal of FC York is to become the premier club for the York USA league
  - Matt Herrington will be the representative within York USA for the FC York club
- **Club logos: club gear (jerseys, warm-ups etc.) and club patch**
  - Donna will begin working on a patch design
  - The club is working on a uniform contract with Adidas
    - Royal Blue and White colors
    - 10% rebate in the form of equipment, etc.
    - \$2,500 fixed rebate each year in the form of equipment, etc.
  - Angelo's will do the distribution of the uniforms

  - Update to provide information for each team
  - Note about tryouts will be added, “tryouts to be posted in March.”
  - Scott will be working in developing a design

- **Director of Coaching: can we afford one in our first year, if so Committee needed to begin search and interview process (Bill Allen and Mick Knaper)**
  - The director of coaching position will provide the following benefits
    - Show up to games and practices and give coaches feedback for improvement
    - Offer workshops and other development opportunities to coaches
    - Report any issues to the officers about coaching performance
    - Recommend player level
  - Cost may be an issue
  
- **Tryout Dates: need to have the dates set by March Meeting**
  - Different dates will be required for multiple teams at the same age group
  - Tim will check to see if we can use the Penn State fields for tryouts
  
- **Board of Director Election in February**
  - Anyone interested in running for an officer and non-officer position should contact Tim
  - Non-Officer Positions
    - Registrar Positions
      - Teams must meet registration deadlines. There will not be exceptions
      - Registration will be done for each league
    - Public Relations
      - Promote club at high schools
      - Place ads and banners in newspapers, local sports facilities, schools, etc.
    - Field Coordinators
      - Liners will be available at multiple locations
      - Develop relationships at high schools for the use of fields
      - Work with parks, i.e. Rudy Park, Cousler Park, etc. to have available fields for games and practices
    - Uniform Coordinator
      - Work directly with Chris at Angelo's
      - Decide on color and design options, etc.
