- Treasurer's Report
  - FC York was very close with the 2008-09 budget.
  - All coaches need to complete the Independent Contract Agreement. This form is on the FC York web site under Forms. No checks will be given out to coaches unless this form is completed.
  
- LANCO
  - Registration must be in by the end of July.
  - Mandatory coaches meeting on August 19, 2009.
  - Lanco Board is discussing not meeting every month.
  
- PAGS
  - Preliminary schedule is out. Tim Holden will be doing the home schedules for PAGS.
  
- DELCO
