- Treasurer Report
  - Dave Stewart stated each team treasurer should make sure that each player's account remains positive. He suggested that no player account should ever have a negative balance.
  - FC York is in good shape with money.

- York USA
  - Club fees were paid back to the clubs. Still trying to get money paid to players that are playing back to their club team. Dan from York USA is going to get together with Tim Holden to talk about the money to give back to the FC York players.
  
- Academy
  - 3 Staff people for the academy
  - Try-outs started: 40 Girls, 30 Boys
  
- October Meeting Minutes were approved.
  
- Fields for Spring
  - See Denise Sandbek to schedule spring practice fields. Rudy Park knows that FC York needs the fields.
  - If training indoor and there is no certificate of insurance, get the form filled out and fax to EPYSA. Once received, Sean will add it to the website.

- Two more liners are needed for Rudy Park. In the spring girls' teams will line two fields and boys' teams will line the other two fields.
- Seed Money from Metro Soccer Club
  - FC York has not received the seed money from Metro.
  - Matt Spahr was owed \$960.00 for training and coaches fees dated April 30 thru June 30, 2008 from Metro.
  - Motion was made and approved to pay Matt Spahr for \$960.00 for Metro training/coaches fees.
- Philanthropic Idea
  - Matt Zimmerman suggested for the 2<sup>nd</sup> indoor session, for each goal scored: the player (or parent) and coach would each put in a dollar per goal. FC York would match the dollars. After the 2<sup>nd</sup> session is over all the money will be put together and given to a charity.
  - Motion was made and approved for FC York to match \$1 per goal for the Philanthropic idea.
- Register
  - Karen Alban will assist with registration next year.

### **FC York needs a new register for next year**

- Angelo's
  - Any items that are to be billed to FC York must first be approved by the board, and then Tim Holden will place the order.
  - If a team wants to order items from Angelo's, the bills need to be sent to that team or paid in advance by the team.
- FC York Magnets.
  - Motion was made and approved to purchase 500 FC York magnets. The magnets will be sold at the FC York meetings for \$5.00 each.
- Age/Grade Appropriate Discussion
  - Most boys' teams already have the majority of their players playing age/grade appropriate. However, the girl's side has an excessive amount of players playing up an age.

- The December meeting, to be held on December 16<sup>th</sup>, will be used as a question and answer session regarding this subject.
- Per FC York By-Laws a ballot will be mailed to each registered player's family to either vote FOR or AGAINST revoking the current player guidelines and mandating all players must play their age and/or grade. Date ballot must be returned to be determined.
