- Treasurer's Report was handed out.  
Two teams still need to pick up their York USA refund checks: 98' Elite Boys and 92' Premier Girls. Six teams still owe the \$50 for Keeper Training fees.
  
- LANCO, CPYSL and PAGS

- DELCO  
Spring registration is due by the end of December.
  
- York USA  
Discussion continues for 8v8 at U11. Vote will be held at the December York USA meeting.
  
- Academy  
Tryouts just wrapped up. Coaches are needed for FC York U10 teams.
  
- October meeting minutes were approved.
  
- Player Hardship Guidelines/Policy  
The Hardship Guideline/Policy was read by Tim Holden. A motion was made and seconded to accept the guidelines. Guidelines were approved and will be placed on the FC York website.
  
- Fundraiser  
Checks were given to the teams that participated. Sold \$5,200, FC York teams profited \$2,000. Cloister fundraiser will not be held in December. Golf Outing Fundraiser will be held May 7th. More details will be available at December/January FC York meeting.

- Ad for Coaches: YDR  
Mick Knaper is going to put an ad in the YDR for FC York coaches. This will also be placed on the FC York website. Donna Thomas will work on the wording for the ad, including the minimum license requirements.
- Try-Out Shirts  
Tim Holden is looking into getting 4 different color shirts: total quantity 1000. Tryout fee will be collected at the first tryout. Shirts will cost approximately \$6.00 each.
- EPYSA Indoor Cups  
Teams need to enter in the appropriate divisions.
- Tournaments/Gotsoccer Rankings  
Teams are accepted or declined in many tournaments, then placed in flights based on their Gotsoccer ranking. Teams need to put their accomplishments on the FC York website by contacting Sean Gross.
- Uniforms 2010/2011  
FC York owns a small supply of the current uniform. The Onore will not be offered for the 2010/11 seasons, therefore new players will receive their uniforms from the inventory, and then go with Adidas t-shirts. Teams can also look to purchase uniforms from players who no longer play for the club, or have out-grown their uniform.
