Tuesday October 28, 2008

- Treasurer – Report was handed out for the month.
 - Coaches fill out schedule C for the following: Expenses for mileage, anything that promotes you as a coach, etc.
- LANCO – Play-offs are November 15 – 16. There will be a \$100.00 fine if your team does not show up. Please notify Nathan Hackos if your team is not playing play-offs.
- DELCO – Delco fines are excessive, so pay attention to their rules.
- Academy – Try-out dates confirmed by the weekend. Dates will be posted on academy web-site. The dates will be given to Sean to put on FC York main web page.
- DOC – Joe Dizio is looking at organizing a “D” license session for the winter. National “C” session middle of November.
 - Joe also stated that he is getting complaints about coaches and parents on the side lines. Coaches need to police their parents and themselves. FC York does not need to have a bad name for ourselves.

- September meeting minutes were approved.

 - Form is complete and will be mailed. Might take up to 3 months to get approval.
 - Several people are looking at trying to get land donated, but can’t get anything until FC York is 501c3 approved.

- Middle School & High School
 - FC York wants to encourage players to play for their schools. Middle or High school.
 - Coaches need to be sensitive to these players at practice time.

- Futsal Balls
 - Chris at Angelo's is selling the Futsal Balls for \$18.00. These balls are better for teams that are training on basketball courts or hard floors for indoor.

- Misc. Items
 - Tim Holden is asking that parents keep their e-mails within FC York club. Parents need to go through the proper channels: Coach / Team Rep., DOC, VP of Boys or Girls, Tim Holden.
 - \$100.00 Registration Fee doesn't pay for indoor rentals, indoor leagues, or indoor / outdoor cups. These are team expenses.
 - Only money coming from FC York treasurer is the coach(s) and trainer fees. (Hotel expenses for coach, food (per diem), and tournament costs are team expenses).

- Coaches Meeting that took place on 10/14/08
 - Tim Holden spoke about teams playing age and grade appropriate. This is #1 priority for next year's teams. (FC York is about the players, not about the coaches).
 - Team reps / coaches need to communicate to parents that have a player playing an age up, that the player should try out for the age and grade appropriate team for next year.
 - Nothing is confirmed as of yet for age and grade appropriate teams for next year. There will be more coaches meetings and discussions on this issue.
