

- Treasurers Report was handed out. We are in good shape so far this year.
- LANCO
 - There was a discussion concerning future U11 and U12 teams. Should they begin playing 8v8 or stay 11v11? Lanco has asked each club to discuss and have their rep ready to discuss/vote at the next meeting.
- CPYSL
 - The CPYSL meeting was cancelled for the month of September.
- PAGS
 - Home teams should enter the score by Monday 8pm. If late, team may be assessed a fine.
- DELCO
 - The DELCO game report must list the referee's name. Both teams are required to enter the game scores.
- York USA
 - York USA gave a check in the amount of \$4,395 to FC York for all players who played secondary to a York USA team. There were 124 players who played fall and spring, and they will receive \$30 each. There were 45 players who only played 1 season, and they will receive \$15 each. Matt Herrington will work with Dave Stewart to get checks and players' names to each team. These funds go directly to the player account.
- Academy
 - Andrew Otterson and Chaz Vennie attended the York USA Coaches Meeting to promote the FC York Academy. Tryouts will be mid November and will be posted on the website as soon as they are finalized. They are looking for the top boys and girls to fill the Academy positions.
- DOC
 - Joe has trained/observed almost every team. He will get with the team(s) that he has not seen and lock down a date.
 - Mark will get to a few teams in the fall, but will work with all boys teams in the spring. Evan Scheffey has been named the Head Coach of the U17 Titans squad.
- August meeting minutes were approved.

- Rudy Park
 - All 4 fields at Rudy Park have been lined. The girls' teams will continue to paint the 2 fields on the right hand side (front and back). The boys' teams will be responsible for painting the 2 fields on the left hand side (front and back). The Rudy Park calendar is up to date on the website. - Player Hardship Committee
 - There have been 6 applications for 10 players submitted to the committee. There was a motion made and approved as follows: Any player looking for club assistance must participate in fund raising. The club will refund the \$125 registration fee based on a match of the fund raisers at the rate of: 100% for players U14 and below and 50% for players U15 and above. Again, up to the maximum of the \$125 registration fee.

- Fundraiser
 - Rob handed out the November fund raiser packets. The club earned \$173.38 in the Chic Fil A fundraiser. This money will be placed in the Hardship account. - Keeper Training Fees

- Future U10 Team Discussion
 - Mick Knaper began a discussion concerning the future of FC York's U10 teams. The discussion points are as follows: Do we continue as we have done for the last 2 years and field an actual U10 team. These teams will not be competitive due to the limits FC York has placed on training and games. Or do we look to bring the U10 program more in line with the Academy. They would train 1 day per week, and use Sundays for either friendly scrimmages or run a second training session.
